
*Introducing an interested person/s to the game of lawn green bowls at Bradley
Stoke Bowls Club.*

For the purpose of introducing a potential member/s to the Club or a member/s of the public wishing to view a game/s they shall be classified as a 'temporary member/s' and it must be ensured that they duly sign the Visitor's book held within the Club's office. This is a requirement of the Club's insurance policy.

This requirement does not apply to members of visiting bowls clubs involved with either Friendly or Competition matches.

To further clarify the above Paragraphs 3.1A and 3.2A below are now embedded in the Club's constitution as follows: -

3.1 A TEMPORARY MEMBER – being a person who, has shown an interest in joining the Club, signed the Visitors Book but not yet paid the appropriate membership fee and shall have no vote.

3.2 A TEMPORARY MEMBER is a person who has signed the Visitors Book, shown an interest in learning more about bowling and/or the Club prior to deciding whether to join and shall have no privileges whatsoever in relation to the use of the Club or premises until they have become a Full, Junior or Social Member.
