Re: Data Protection Act Competitions 2022

You may recall that in May 2018, the Data Protection Act came into force. We as the League must still comply with its requirements

In essence, it means that if, the League, publishes the name of a competitor, together with his contact details, The League has to have the competitor's consent in writing to do so.

In order to arrive at the Competitor's consent. The comprehensive Entry Form; you would normally post on your Club's Notice Board. Has been replaced with one which is tailored to the Individual. A template is attached. Can you arrange for copies to be printed and made available. To your members, who wish to enter the Competitions

You will see that each Entry Form contains a section entitled **Data Protection Requirements**. It is imperative that each Competitor, answers the statement's listed in that section and when completed, **Date it**.

On your side of the fence, it means that you will have to collect all the individual Entry Forms, collate them onto the Summary Sheet. Which together with the individual sheets and remittances to be forwarded to me, prior to, or at the General Meeting of the League But no later than the end of January 2022

I have also attached a Notice for your Club's Notice Board, relating to the filling out of the individual Competition Entry Form
