

BSBC INTERNAL COMPETITION NOTES

PLAY DATES

After the draw has been made the Competition Secretary fixes the play by dates. It is then the responsibility of the “challenger”, that is, the person whose name appears first in the draw table be it singles, pairs or triples, to agree a date to play the match.

BOOKING A RINK

The “challenger” must then book a rink by contacting Steve Lee (01173 306417).

MARKERS (IF REQUIRED)

The “challenger” agrees with the opponent(s) who should act as a marker and arranges for the person to be there on the specified date and time.

DRESS CODE

For all matches before the final the dress code is greys. The finals are played in whites.

MATCH DURATION

Singles (4-woods) – first to reach 21 shots.

Singles (2-woods) – 21 ends *

Pairs (4-woods) – 21 ends *

Triples (3-woods) – 18 ends *

* if the scores are tied then play one extra end.

RECORDING RESULT

Please put your scorecard in the wallet on the office notice board and fill in the draw table which is also on the office notice board.

TROPHY AWARDS

Last season’s winners will be asked to return the trophies to the Competition Secretary in time for them to be presented to this season’s winners at the finals which are usually held in early September. Once they have been presented the Competitions Secretary will take them back and arrange for them to be engraved. The engrave trophies will be handed back at the AGM in October.
